STATEMENT FROM LAURA KING MOON, ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER OF THE STATE WATER CONTRACTORS, IN RESPONSE TO SWP ALLOCATIONS

Sacramento, CA – “Public water agencies are grateful the recent storms provided a small boost in our statewide water supply but the crisis remains. Drought conditions and severe regulatory restrictions continue to significantly limit how much water we can deliver to people, farms and businesses. Even if the state had received ample rainfall and snowmelt this year, we still couldn’t move it through our broken delivery system. Not only do we need to conserve as much as possible, California must push forward with a long-term term solution for our Delta.”
